Annual Earlham Fire Department Report

2016

Summary- This summary report is a look back at the activities and operations over the 2016 calendar year. We hope this report gives you a better understanding of how we function and what we do.

On behalf of the men and women whom are proud to call themselves members of the Earlham Fire Rescue, Thank You for your continued support!!

Operations- The operations section is the most visible part within the EFR. Our highly trained first responders specialized in fire mitigation, hazardous materials incidents , motor vehicle accidents and rescues. Members are also responsible for Storm Spotting during severe weather events. The department responded to 73 calls for service this past year.

23 volunteers make up our current roster, all of who are on call 24/7/365. All fire fighters are Nationally certified to the Fire Fighter 1 level with a Hazardous Materials Operation classification with the exception of our newest member who just joined as a probationary member in November. 10 of the fire fighters are Nationally Certified to the Fire Fighter2 level. Collectively, 596 fire fighters responded to alarms this past year for Earlham FD. This gives an average response to alarms at 8 fire fighters per call.

Training- The State of Iowa requires all structural fire fighters conduct a minimum of 24 hours training. On average 22 of the members logged in over 34 hours of training this past year. We had 22 members put in collectively 767.25 hours of total training time.

Several of the members attended the Annual Winter Fire School held in Ames at the Fire Service Training Bureau.

Our department was very fortunate to obtain an abandoned house to use for training. The department members put their skills to the test covering search and rescue, water application and air pack training along with apparatus operations.

Administrative- The EFD hasn't seen much for change in upper management in several years. Chief Shawn Boyle was once again elected by the members to head the department. This was Chief Boyle's 16th year as Fire Chief. Assistant Chief, Doug Waugh has been the Assistant Chief for the last 16 years also and Doug celebrated his 40th year of service to the community of Earlham. Dave Boyd is the 2nd Assistant Chief and has been so for 6 years. All 3 of these men work well with each other and the entire department. Strong leadership at the top helps to keep moral up and other department members actively involved.

During 2016, the department took on 3 fire fighters and 1 probationary member, Don Mudge, Clayton Klisaris & Dustin Murray all spent over 100 hours attending the Dallas County Fire Academy in preparation for becoming one of Earlham's finest. Garrett Boyle is our probationary member and his plans include going to college & studying Fire Sciences while being a member of our department.

In October, ISO (Insurance Safety Offices) completed their every 3 year inspection of the city and department. This inspection had not been complete since 2006 and the city has done its part in preparing for such inspections. The public works department and the fire department together with all of the improvements done to water supply, apparatus and training should improve our fire rating.

Also in October, The Fire Department hosted a Fire Prevention tour of our facility and was able to present fire safety education to children in grades Pre-K through 4th grade from the school. Each child received a bag of fire safety material and a plastic fire helmet as a token from us. The department also joined with the State Fire Marshall's office and did a smoke detector drive which members of the department went to homes in the Earlham area and installed approximately 50 smoke detectors.

It has been another great year for the fire department here in Earlham and we hope that 2017 bring the same.
